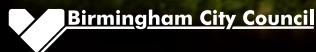

Tickets are prices are as listed on the front of the flyer. Over 60s, unwaged and groups of 8 or more are eligible for the discounted prices listed. Wheelchair users / disabled are eligible for a 50% discount on full price tickets for themselves and a companion.
